CASE STUDY LAZYDAYS FESTIVAL

Lazydays Festival is an independent, family-friendly music and craft drinks festival held at Priory Park in Southend-on-Sea. The 2025 edition ran from 25 to 27 July 2025 and featured a dynamic program of live music acts, artisan food and drink vendors, children's activities, craft-drink masterclasses, talks, and much more.

Set in a residential park, the festival required careful sound management to balance community needs with local authority expectations.
